

## REGISTER TO WALK & FUNDRAISE

The Summit Center Autism Walk is our largest fundraiser. All attending participants and those fundraising must be registered. Participants can register to Walk by clicking on the "Register" button in the top menu. Participants 12 years and older must register and pay the registration fee. During registration you may make a personal donation to your individual fundraising page in addition to your registration fee or you do come back and do so at any time.

### Start a Team

- Recruit a team of 5 or more members. The average team has 10-15 members.
- Set a fundraising goal for your team. (We highly encourage each team member to raise \$100)
- Personalize your team & individual fundraising pages with photos, videos, and your "Why I Walk" story
- Distribute participant collection forms and other fundraising tools to all team members.
- Coach and motivate your team to success using all available forms of communication to generate enthusiasm and participation for the event (i.e., email, phone calls, Facebook, newsletters).
- Coordinate creative fundraisers to help your team raise money.
- Recognize team members for their commitment to Summit and autism awareness.

### Join a Team

- Join an existing team by registering, selecting "Join a Team" and then choosing the team you wish to join.
- Set a fundraising goal and collect donations from friends, family, neighbors, and colleagues. (We highly encourage each participant to raise \$100)
- Personalize your individual fundraising pages with photos, videos, and your "Why I Walk" story

### Join as an Individual

- By joining as an individual you will not be associated with a team. If you plan on attending the Walk with others, please Start a Team.
- Set a fundraising goal and collect donations from friends, family, neighbors, and colleagues. (We highly encourage each participant to raise \$100)
- Personalize your individual fundraising pages with photos, videos, and your "Why I Walk" story

## MAKE A DONATION

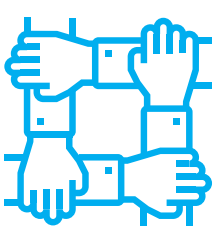

### Donate to a Participant

- Once processed your donation will count towards their overall fundraising total on the side bar of their page. You may choose to add your name and donation amount to the donor scroll while making your donation.

## 2017 WALK CHANGES



### ROUTE

The route will increase from 3.1 to 4 miles. We will be adding a water station at the half-way point. The short route will remain the same.



### REGISTRATION

Every participant under the age of 12 years old must register and pay the \$5 registration fee. We will be holding a packet pick-up day on 4/21/17. Those not registered on Walk Day will be required to register to receive their bib and food ticket.
